

GI Bill and other education benefit eligibility

VA education benefits help Veterans, service members, and their qualified family members with needs like paying college tuition, finding the right school or training program, and getting career counseling.

Before we can determine your eligibility for Veteran's education benefits, we need an up-to-date copy of your **Certificate of Eligibility (COE)**. You can order this online at <https://www.va.gov/education/eligibility/>. Once you receive it, email it to cknestrick@cvccworks.edu or bring it to the Adult Education Office at CVCC. Chapter 33 pays the tuition cost to the school directly. All other chapters pay the tuition cost to the Veteran directly. Students need to arrange for either self-pay with a monthly payment plan or utilize federal financial aid for all out of pocket costs to the student.
