Maintenance Technician Job Description

East Akron Neighborhood Development Corporation (EANDC) is a Not-For-Profit 501(c)(3) Charitable Housing Development Organization. EANDC develops, owns, and manages market rate and affordable housing for low-income, elderly, and veteran residents in Summit County and Stark County, Ohio. We are the largest provider of affordable housing in Metropolitan Akron. EANDC also provides home buying counseling, energy efficiency audits, free energy-efficient appliances, social services, community and event coordination, and more to qualified Summit and Stark County residents.

General Responsibilities and Essential Functions:

The Maintenance Technician is a non-exempt full-time position that reports to the Property Maintenance Manager and Chief Real Estate Development Officer ("CREDO") and is responsible for assisting in all aspects of our property's maintenance, including grounds, custodial, preventative, corrective, deferred, and emergency maintenance. General tasks and responsibilities of this role are outlined below.

Maintenance Technician Job Description

Required Skills:

- Hands-on skills in plumbing, electrical, HVAC, carpentry, painting, and general building maintenance.
- Proficiency with hand tools, power tools, and diagnostic equipment.
- Ability to read, understand, and complete work orders (paper or digital).
- Ability to work early morning or late-night shifts.
- Ability to work extra events.
- Ability to work well under minimal supervision.
- Capacity to take direction and have a strong attention to detail.
- Knowledge of Hazardous Communication Protocols and use of PPE.
- Willingness to work in a team atmosphere.

Required Qualifications:

- Minimum 2–3 years of property or facility maintenance experience (residential, commercial, or mixed-use).
- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Must be able to pass a pre-employment criminal background check and drug screening.
- Willingness to work on-call rotations, evenings, and weekends.
- Willingness to work on extra events, as needed.

Preferred Qualifications:

• HVAC/EPA Certification, OSHA 10/30, or trade licenses (electrical, plumbing, etc.).

Work Environment:

- Fieldwork at client locations, including residential homes.
- Office work for data analysis, report writing, and client consultation.
- May require travel to different sites and occasional work in confined spaces or at heights.
- May require occasional overtime as needed.
- This is a full-time, on-site position, generally beginning at 8:00 a.m., Monday through Friday.

Physical Demands:

This position requires the ability to lift, carry, push, and pull up to 30 pounds on a regular basis, with occasional heavier lifting assisted by team members or equipment. The role involves frequent standing, walking, bending, kneeling, crouching, climbing ladders, and working in confined spaces. A Maintenance Technician must be able to work both indoors and outdoors in varying weather conditions, safely operate hand and power tools, and use maintenance equipment with proper manual dexterity. Clear vision and hearing are required to identify maintenance issues and operate equipment safely. The position may also require quick physical responses in emergency situations.
