Dear Parent/Guardian of Cuyahoga Valley Career Center Students:

Happy New Year! We are very proud to acknowledge the efforts of our students and staff during this past holiday season to provide service related projects for our communities. CVCC's Power Equipment Technology program hosted a food drive and collected over 2,461 lbs. of food from our various programs. These items have been donated to local food centers in Ohio. Also, thank you to our SkillsUSA students who participated in the National Wreaths Across America Day event at the Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery.

We are now into the season of school delays and closings. Please review the following information concerning delays and closings due to inclement weather.

CLOSINGS

If CVCC elects to close school, there are multiple communication modes that are used to let our students and their families know that CVCC is closed.

1. An alert call is made to the homes of CVCC student's primary phone contact via the school district's outbound dialing phone system.
2. CVCC provides information to the local major television stations and some radio stations that CVCC is closed.
3. A message is posted on the CVCC's main web page.
4. A recorded message is posted on the CVCC's message phone number 440-838-8900.

If your local school district is closed because of inclement weather and CVCC is open, your student may attend CVCC (by finding their own transportation to and from CVCC), however the student is excused from attending CVCC for that day. CVCC will only contact you if there is a closing of Cuyahoga Valley Career Center. In the event of an emergency at CVCC an alert call will be sent out using the contact information you have provided for your student. Please be sure that all contact information is up to date.

DELAYS

CVCC does not delay the opening of school due to inclement weather. If a local school district has implemented a delay for the start of school due to inclement weather and CVCC is open, your student may attend the AM session at CVCC by finding their own transportation to CVCC. However, the student is excused from attending the AM session at CVCC.

If a student has arranged their own transportation to CVCC for the AM session and needs transportation to their local school district at the conclusion of the AM session, the local school district will arrange for transportation. When your home school is closed due to severe weather, students are excused from attending CVCC. If there is no school at your home school due to teacher in-service, etc. and CVCC is in session, students are expected to attend CVCC and your school will provide transportation from the high school to CVCC and back to the High School.

As the semester comes to a close, I would like you to be aware of activities taking place for the remainder of the school year. The enclosed calendar information will hopefully be beneficial. Please contact me at (440) 746-8281 if you have any questions.
