- Enrollment in one of the following programs: **EKG Technician, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Fiber Optic Technician (FOT), Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC), Machining Technology, Phlebotomy, Practical Nursing, State Tested Nurse Aide (STNA)**
- Student's financial need
- Scholarship funds are intended as last dollar funds* (loans not included)

Each applicant is to provide:

- Completed and signed **application**
- Documentation of any required program **pre-requisites**
- Typed **250-500 word essay** describing your career goals, financial need and how this scholarship would help you overcome barriers to enrolling in a post-secondary education workforce program. Essay must be carefully proofread and free of spelling/grammar errors. Please see an Administrative Assistant for help, if needed. See back of this page for contact information.
